7 day angling membership – fish any day of the week

Day tickets can be purchased in advance by calling 01926 645500 (Tuesday-Sunday and Bank Holiday Mondays 11am-5pm) using a credit card or pay at the ticket lodge on the day. The ticket lodge is open Tuesday-Sunday and Bank Holiday Mondays 11am-5pm.

Angling membership benefits:

- Exclusive member only fishing, limited membership
- Invitation to an annual social event
- Portaloo in grounds and secure parking (CCTV controlled)
- Compton Verney What's on guide or monthly e-bulletin (optional)
- Admission to the collections, grounds and café. There will be a charge if you wish to upgrade to an exhibition ticket.

Before completing the joining form please take a moment to look through the rules below

Rules

General rules

- Anglers can only have access to the site if they carry membership cards which **must be displayed on your outer garment at all times.**
- **Valid EA rod** and line licences must be carried at all times
- All anglers under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Anglers must be discrete about catches as we operate a “No Publicity” policy.

Site rules (also see attached map)

- Fishing is dawn to dusk only
- The closed season will be observed by all members (15 March – 15 June)
- No air guns or firearms (**please be wary at times we shoot pests**)
- No swimming
- No radios
- No fires or camping stoves (no cooking permitted on site)
- Do not disturb/damage the wildlife, vegetation, trees or fences.

- Take your litter home or use bins provided
- Only park in main car park & **display valid car park pass at all times** (we put hazard tape across when we are closed to the public in the winter, anglers are still allowed in to park and access the lake).
- Only use the agreed routes from the car park the new pathways and mulched paths off of those pathways to avoid new planting – see attached site map for details.
- Fish from pegs only (1 member per peg except 5) no angling permitted elsewhere (see map for peg locations)
- Please use portaloo provided at all times **code 177**
- If you do not recognise an angler please check for membership. If you are uncomfortable with this or if you see any suspicious or unlawful behaviour please contact the local police on 01789 414111 out of hours or during opening hours please inform Security or member of Compton Verney staff.
- Please notify a member of staff if you see any mink, number of fish in poor health, wildlife in distress, etc.

Coarse fishing rules

- A maximum of two rods in use for each angler
- Barbless hooks only, except on Pike tackle.
- Lines must be reeled in before leaving them unattended
- No carp or large fish (over 4lb) to be retained in keep nets
- No fish to be removed from Compton Verney or to be used as bait
- Only weigh fish in a sling or landing net and return to water immediately
- Always use an un-hooking mat for large fish especially Carp
- No bait boats
- No elasticated method feeders
- **No pre baiting**
- **No excessive baiting (please use common sense not to exceed 5 litres per day)**
- All particles must be prepared properly before use
- No wading
- **Roach up to 5" can be used for livebaiting when Pike fishing (caught from Compton Verney waters no other live fish to be brought in)**
- No tents (Bivvies can be used)

Carp fishing rules

When carp fishing all the above rules must be observed together with the following:

- Minimum of 10lb mainline
- No braided mainline
- No sacking of fish
- No peanuts are to be used

Compton Verney House Trust staff and members reserve the right to run checks on all the above rules.

The rules will be reviewed annually.

***Anglers who fail to observe the rules will be asked to leave and lose their membership indefinitely.**



How to join

To join the angling membership you need to:

- Complete the attached joining form
- Attach a passport size photo of yourself
- Provide a photocopy of your rod license

The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit, Compton Verney will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Compton Verney to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Compton Verney or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Compton Verney asks you to
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required.
