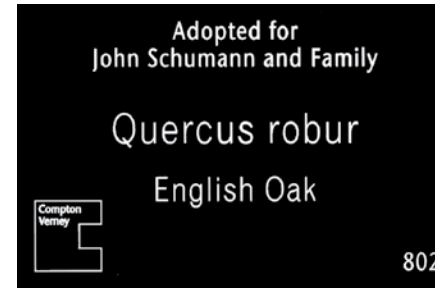
Notes

- Depending on the location of the tree, we may not weed or cut the grass surrounding the tree.
- In the unlikely event that an adopted tree should die or have to be removed for some unforeseen reason within 10 years of adoption, the donor will be offered an alternative at no extra charge.
