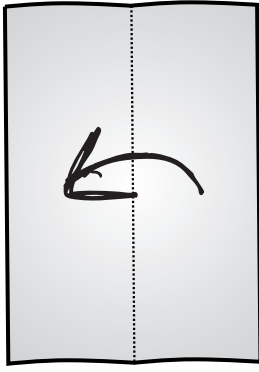
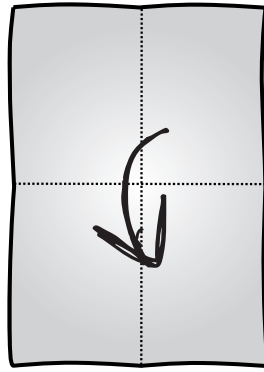


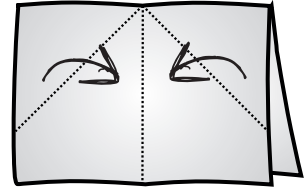
Make your own paper boat



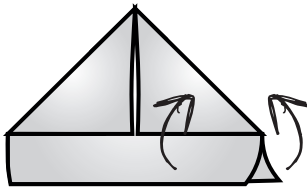
1. Take an A4 sheet of paper and fold it in half. Open out.



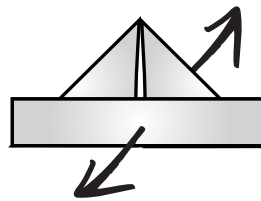
2. Fold it again in the opposite direction.



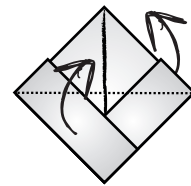
3. Fold the two upper corners down to the centre line.



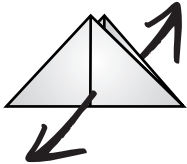
4. Fold the lower edge of the uppermost layer upwards. Turn it over and do the same to the back.



5. Fold the lower edge of the uppermost layer upwards. Turn it over and do the same to the back.



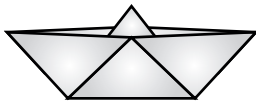
6. Fold the bottom point of the uppermost layer up to meet the top point. Turn it over and repeat.



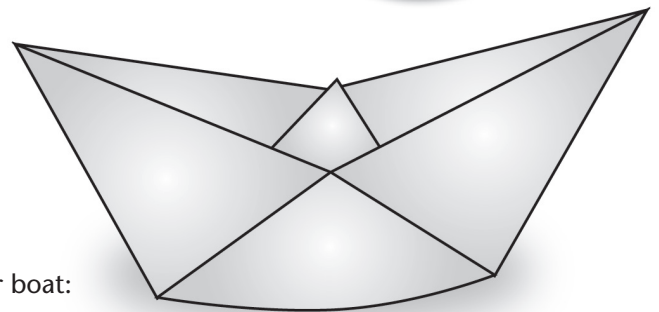
7. Pull the sides of the triangle out carefully and flatten to form a diamond.



8. Gently pull the top parts of the diamond outwards to form the shape of the boat.



9. Flatten well to crease all folds and open out slightly.
