Compton Verney House Trust and galleries are looking for a freelance digital curator or producer to work with us over the next 4 months to help create a forward plan for digital project development and to deliver one high profile online project in summer 2021 and develop and scope an ambitious gallery based exhibition/ commission for 2023.

This is a freelance role with a fixed fee of £ 8,000 starting May 2021 until August/ September 2021.

Project Brief/ Role description:

Compton Verney Art Gallery and Park, nine miles from Stratford upon Avon, is a stunning location where art and landscape meet. Compton Verney offers visitors of all ages a place for discovery, play and reflection, somewhere to have fun, explore, learning and experience. Founded with the mission to make art, culture and natural environment accessible to all, we are a place for exciting exhibitions of the highest quality, the world class collections ranging from ancient Chinese bronzes to British and European fine and decorative arts, to British Folk Art and 20th century design. It is also a place where people enjoy and engage with the natural environment and heritage through contemporary experiences.

We are seeking a digital curator or producer to help us develop unique, accessible and high quality digital content that is accessible to existing and new audiences. We want to create a sustainable programme that is unique and becomes part of our core programme – ensuring that the digital space offers the same enriching and accessible environment as our physical spaces. Through digital programming we want to create relevant content and connections with audiences of all ages - locally, nationally and internationally.

About this role:

This 4-month freelance role will be to help scope out and deliver our first fully fledged digital projects aligning to Compton Verney's values and brand. The work and will fall into 3 phases:

1. Develop and deliver *On –Colour*, a project to explore the theory and use of colour in the work of artists, academics and curators in an accessible, fun and unique way. This will be a multi artform project embedding learning experiences and engagement activity within the project that will be experienced by audiences online.
2. R&D: Scope and develop the groundwork and commissioning basis for a large scale immersive digital environment that audiences will experience in gallery an online for 2023.
3. Create a series of recommendations for future digital programme across our grounds, galleries, collections and online spaces.

About you:

You will be an organised, experienced and imaginative freelancer with proven experience in creating and developing a diverse range of digital and online projects including:

- Over 5 years' experience of creating digital exhibition content online and in gallery as well as online education projects
- Proven project management skills
- An excellent multi-tasker able to deliver project on budget and to tight deadlines
- Ability to work flexibly and remotely but also work on site as required
